### Breakout Session Schedule Now Available 3rd Annual NE Arizona Substance Abuse Summit

Full details on the 24 breakout sessions and two noted speakers for the 3<sup>rd</sup> Annual Northeastern Arizona Substance Abuse Summit are now available on line.

Local and state speakers and panels present breakout sessions for the Sept. 16th event. Topics include: LDS Abuse & Substance Program, Underage Drinking & Social Hosting Laws; Youth in Service Learning; National Guard's Demand Reduction Education Program; Drug Issues in Whiteriver; WeTip Crime Hotline; US Drug Enforcement Agency's Drug Trends in Arizona; Issues & Solutions for Veterans; Junior Leadership Academies for At Risk Kids; Drug Dog Education; Prescription Drug Abuse & Teen Brain Research; Arizona Youth Survey; Child Protection Services Today; Gang Prevention; and Salvation Army Mountain youth activities and treatment. Additionally, displays and information will be available.

This year's event features national speaker Susie Vanderlip, Robin Stamp from the Arizona Attorney General's Office. Additionally, there are a dozen related display booths. The Navajo County Superintendent of Schools accredits the 8 am to 4 pm summit at Northland Pioneer College Silver Creek Campus Performing Arts Center, Snowflake, for continuing education hours. The \$25 advance registration fee includes catered lunch and continental breakfast. Advance registration closes Sept. 12. Registration at the door is \$30, on a space available basis.
